TOPIC: ABOUT MY FAMILY

This achievement standard involves using Chinese to give a spoken presentation about my family that communicates a personal response.

Conditions:

- This presentation must be entirely your own work but your supervisor does not have to be present while you prepare and practise it.
- The actual recording must be done with your supervisor present. If you are attending a school this must be a supervisor from your school.
- Your recording needs to be saved in a digital format and uploaded to the ZHO1008Y1 OTLE assessment dropbox.
- You may do the assessment at any time but it is best to complete modules ZHO1001– ZHO1008 first.
- You should try to **talk on the topic for about one minute**, as anything less won't give you the chance to show your ability to communicate in Chinese.
- You may have the text of the speech with you, or use notes such as cue cards to help you. However, you must not read your speech straight from your notes as it will then be 'reading aloud' rather than a presentation.
- Record your presentation. Don't forget to check that your recording is clear and audible.
- Submit all notes used during recording via the OTLE drobpbox.
- Plagiarism detection software may be used to check this is your own work.

Supervisor requirements

A supervisor must be present at specified times for this assessment. You must provide the full name of the supervisor and their relationship to you (e.g. parent, teacher, teacher aide etc.) when you upload your assessment to the ZHO1008Y1 OTLE assessment dropbox.

Student instructions

Read through all the information given to you before starting any preparation work. Make sure that you:

- · understand what you are asked to do
- understand what is required to obtain Achieved, Merit or Excellence
- give your name, school and ID number at the beginning of your presentation.
