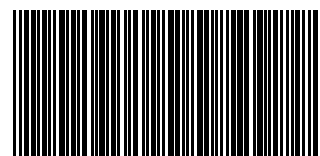

*Comprehensively analyse practices* involves explaining how and why practices to enhance well-being are applied from the perspective of society.
- Care provision may include the use of care providers, paid care in the home, day care centres, rest homes, respite care, drop in facilities, after-school care, family-friendly workplaces within New Zealand.

Write a report in which you analyse the practices used to enhance wellbeing in the Early Childhood Education provider you observed in HEO2007.

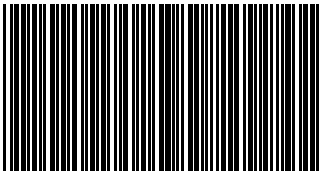
In your report:
